6.4 STUDENT IDEAS EXPO



Time required	50 minutes
Grade level	7 - 8
Resources required	<ul> <li>Our Student Ideas Expo worksheet (below)</li> <li>Book a large room and set up dependent upon numbers attending</li> <li>Students to bring their pitches, any presentation materials and a copy of the Our Student Ideas worksheet to record feedback</li> </ul>
Aims	<ul> <li>To present action project ideas to an audience to gain feedback and enlist support.</li> </ul>
Procedure	<ul> <li>Pre-selected students are to:</li> <li>welcome the school principal and community organisation representatives; and</li> <li>explain the Student Ideas Expo and invite everyone to visit the various tables.</li> <li>Students present their pitches to rotating groups of guests. Teams get feedback about their idea and whether it is approved to go ahead.</li> </ul>
Teacher notes	<ul> <li>A Fairer World will send invitations for the Student Ideas Expo to all those who attended the introductory assembly, community organisations, human "books" and other school and community members.</li> <li>Ensure that students adhere to their presentation roster so that all team members have an opportunity to visit other booths.</li> </ul>
