Time required	50 minutes
Grade level	7 - 8
Resources required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Our Student Ideas Expo worksheet (below) ■ Book a large room and set up dependent upon numbers attending ■ Students to bring their pitches, any presentation materials and a copy of the Our Student Ideas worksheet to record feedback
Aims	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ To present action project ideas to an audience to gain feedback and enlist support.
Procedure	<p>Pre-selected students are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ welcome the school principal and community organisation representatives; and ■ explain the Student Ideas Expo and invite everyone to visit the various tables. <p>Students present their pitches to rotating groups of guests. Teams get feedback about their idea and whether it is approved to go ahead.</p>
Teacher notes	<p>A Fairer World will send invitations for the Student Ideas Expo to all those who attended the introductory assembly, community organisations, human “books” and other school and community members.</p> <p>Ensure that students adhere to their presentation roster so that all team members have an opportunity to visit other booths.</p>
